PUBLIC PORTION OF MEETING:

Pam Grenier of 348 Wheat Road asked why \$110,000 was being taken from the MUA for the second year in a row and what will the money be used for. She believes the MUA will have to raise the rates if the money continues to be taken every year.

Brian Fatcher of Kimberly Lane asked if a drainage study was done before the paving was completed on Weymouth Road. Bob Smith advised he did reach out to the county and they didn't provide the study.

Ken Lewis of 125 Irene Avenue asked why we needed the money for the MUA. He wanted a guarantee MUA rates won't go up.

Bill Coltri of Forest Grove Road was following up on debris piled behind his property from a landscaper that hasn't been removed yet. Councilman McAvaddy stated he sent an email and didn't get a response.

Jeff Johnston of Cedar Lake Road has concerns with drain water at Cedar Lake Road and Central Avenue. Also, the tree branches were never trimmed back.

He also had concerns regarding the driveway at Black Water Pond and asked who maintained it.

Dave Armanini of 205 East Summer Avenue was following up on his concerns with flooding over flowing from the cemetery. Bob Smith advised he did reach out and they will be building a basin. They are waiting for the weather to get better.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 593, AS AMENDED,
ARTICLE XXVII, SECTION 35-95 OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF BUENA ENTITLED BOROUGH ADMINISTRATOR
m/Baker s/Alvarez**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Buena adopted Ordinance 592 creating the position Borough Administrator for the efficient operation of the administration of the Borough of Buena; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council set the hours to be served in the position as not more than 20 hours on average per week; and

WHEREAS, the duties and obligations of the Borough Administrator have increased and it is clear that the position will require more than 20 hours per week to be effective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Buena that Article XXVII, Section 35-95 be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Section 35-95. The office of the Business Administrator is hereby established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-136 et seq. Said position to be a part-time position of not more than a gross number of hours equal to a calculation based upon 20 hours per week times 48 weeks in the calendar year of service. At no time shall the Business Administrator work in excess of 29 hours in any week. The hours shall be flex to be used in the discretion of the Administrator unless otherwise directed by the Mayor, however all flex hours accumulated must be taken within 2 weeks of acquiring the same.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Business Administrator shall execute a Memorandum of Agreement setting forth the terms of employment, including the term of office, salary and hours of daily service among other terms.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any Ordinance or portion thereof that is inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any portion of this Ordinance be deemed void by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the balance hereof shall remain in full force and affect.

The contractor intends to begin construction once the weather improves.

The contracts for the resurfacing have been fully executed and an executed copy was sent to the contractor. A pre-construction meeting took place on January 3, 2018. The resurfacing component of the project will proceed once the culvert replacement is complete.
